# REPORT ON THE PROVISION OF CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT 2011-2012

#### **EVALUATION**

Initial feedback of the Mentoring Initiatives in Teaching and Learning for newly appointed staff is excellent: "Great idea to promote IL throughout the staff. Also great for useful ideas for classroom management and brushing up on your skills."

Evaluation of the Gaeilge CPD reported that the content was very good, meeting the teachers' expectations and that the presenter's delivery was excellent.

Reports on the Project Maths CPD in October stated that it was excellent in all respects.

The CPD on "Video in Home Economics" was "a good opportunity to network with other Home Economics teachers" and "a great sharing of classroom resources and knowledge".

In relation to further studies being undertaken by staff, there is a recognition the Certificate in Special Education involves "demanding course work that required a lot of time in participation and completion". However, the further study enhances "doing my job". The Certificate in Special Education increased knowledge "about all types of disability and learning difficulties which was beneficial" in the context of the ASD unit.

The Certificate Course for SNA's involved a significant commitment of time at weekends. It was intense, well organised and worthwhile.

Serco Training on Scheduler timetabling, admin and e portal was good.

Reports on "Using ICT and other Digital Resources in Teaching 2<sup>nd</sup> Year History"£ (PDST, Kildare Ed.) were excellent – in all respects: "Fantastic course. Gave excellent IT resources for incorporating into classes."

The mentoring programme for recently appointed staff worked well, with participants appreciating having the support and advice of mentors. There was particular commendation of the incorporation of Instructional Leadership into the 6 sessions. The session on parent teacher meetings proved very useful. Participants requested further up-skilling on managing challenging students. The collaborative, collegial approach was noted successful. The Boardroom may not have been the best venue for some of the more practical sessions where a classroom might have proved more effective.
