
First Aid For Tonic Clonic Seizures

Convulsive seizures where the body stiffens (tonic phase) followed by general muscle jerking (clonic phase)



1. DO time the seizure



4. DO look for Epilepsy I.D.



2. DO remove any harmful objects



5. DON'T put anything in the person's mouth



8. DO stay with the person until the seizure ends and offer assistance

Complex Partial Seizures

7. DO turn the person

on side (into recovery

position) when seizure

(Non-convulsive seizures with confusion, wandering, unusual behaviours)

- Stay with the person
- Time the seizure
- Guide away from any danger
 Speak gently and calmly to
- <u>reassure the per</u>son
- DON'T restrain the person unless in danger



3. DO cushion the head



6. DON'T restrain the person or move unless in danger

- If the seizure is longer than 5 minutes
- If one seizure follows another without stopping
- If you know it is the person's first seizure
- If the person is injured
- If you are in any doubt
